What Are Cookies ?	<p>Cookies are tiny files that are downloaded to your computer with the aim of improving your experience and customer journey.</p> <p>This page describes what information they gather, how we use it and why we sometimes need to store these cookies.</p>
Why do you gather, use and store cookies?	<p>We provide the functionality to set your preferences for how this site runs when you use it to provide you with the best site we can. In order to remember your preferences we need to set cookies so that this information can be called whenever you interact with a page is affected by your preferences.</p> <p>We use cookies when you are logged in so that we can remember this fact. This prevents you from having to log in every single time you visit a new page. These cookies are typically removed or cleared when you log out to ensure that you can only access restricted features and areas when logged in.</p> <p>This site offers newsletter or email subscription services and cookies may be used to remember if you are already registered and whether to show certain notifications which might only be valid to subscribed/unsubscribed users.</p> <p>When you submit data to one of our forms cookies may be set to remember your user details for future correspondence and you will receive automatic messages from our site about your enquiry or booking.</p>

<p>Do you use Third Party Cookies and what for?</p>	<p>We also use cookies provided by trusted third parties. The third party Cookies we use are to help us improve our school and reach out organically to new clients.</p> <p>From time to time we test new features and make changes to the way that the site is delivered. When we are still testing new features these cookies may be used to ensure that you receive a consistent experience whilst ensuring we understand which optimisations our users appreciate the most.</p> <p>Third party analytics are also used to track and measure usage of this site so that we can continue to produce engaging content. These cookies may track things such as how long you spend on the site or pages you visit which helps us to understand how we can improve the site for you. We use Google Analytics (one of the most widespread and trusted analytics solution on the web). The cookies track your journey through our website such as how long you spend on the site, the pages that you visit and the ones you leave. It allows us to see which pages are useful to our clients and understand how you use the site. We then use this to produce more engaging useful content and improve your experience. You can find more information on Google Analytics cookies on the official Google Analytics page.</p> <p>As we sell products it's important for us to understand statistics about how many of the visitors to our site actually make a purchase and as such this is the kind of data that these cookies will track. This is important to you as it means that we can accurately make business predictions that allow us to monitor our advertising and product costs to ensure the best possible outcomes.</p>
